1. What is the truest thing that you know? How did you come to this conclusion?

2. Take a blank sheet of paper. Do with this page what you wish but your page should not be blank. Your only limitations are the boundaries of this page. Scan or take a picture and upload your page. If your piece is largely or exclusively visual, please make sure to share a creator's accompanying statement of 100 - 500 words, which we will happily allow to be on its own, separate page.

- 3. Imagine you could be bold and brave for a day, just what would you do?
- 4. "If you could choose to be raised by robots, dinosaurs, or aliens, who would you pick? Why?"

Choose the essay that plays to your strength. Read the prompt carefully THINK, THINK, THINK!
